



Hen Party Options and Prices 2019

(revised and inc VAT)

We aim to make your Hen Party the best ever!

1. Hen 'Scenic Farm Trek' - Enjoy a fun introduction to llamas and alpacas and be matched to their personalities! (we call it - 'llama speed dating')!

1 hour 30 mins trekking, over approx 1.5 miles. Return to the farm for cakes and drinks.

2 people sharing one llama - £44.00 each

To Trek with a llama each - £54 each.

Maximum 17 llamas/alpacas.

Session approx - 3 hours.

For a private session you must book a minimum of 10 animals.

2. Hen Scenic Farm Trek & Lunch

Same as above but with buffet lunch and drinks included.

2 people share one llama £55.00 each

To Trek with a llama each - £65.00 each.

Maximum 17 llamas/alpacas.

Session approx 3 hours 45 mins

For a private session you must book a minimum of 10 animals.

3. Hen Half Day with lunch - A longer trek stopping on route in a lovely woodland area for beverages (carried by the llamas)! They can even carry your champagne down to the woods if you desire! This trek goes through 3.5 miles of beautiful country side and back to the farm for buffet lunch and cakes.

2 people share one llama £70.00 each

To Trek with a llama each - £90.00 each

Maximum 12 llamas.

Session approx 5 hours

For a private session you must book a minimum of 8 llamas.

4. Hen Interactive Experience - less walking, more talking.

An interactive introduction to llamas and alpacas including lots of photo opportunities. A llama or alpaca each for a 45-minute walk out on the farm. Returning to the barn for cakes and drinks.

£45 each

Maximum 12 llamas/alpacas

Session approx 1 hour 45 minutes.

For a private session you must book a minimum of 10 llamas.

Buffets - We offer a choice of 2 options.

For all the above options, (where food included), the price refers to the 'standard' buffet. The Deluxe buffet is an additional £6.00 pr head on top of the above trek prices. All food is locally produced and of top Quality.

Please note we do cater for all dietary requirements just let us know on booking of any special diet needs.

Standard Buffet - Sandwich selection, locally produced, quiche, pork pies or sausage rolls/ & or cheese & onion rolls, crisps and snacks, followed by cakes.

'Hen Style Deluxe' - Sandwiches & wraps selection, quiche, sausage roll, pork pie, snacks, crisps followed by fresh fruit & Hen Party cup cakes!

Drinks consist of mixed fizzy and still cold drinks, with tea or coffee to finish your meal. (Standard & Deluxe).

Champagne - If you would like to include champagne, we recommend you bring it with you. However, if this is awkward for you then we can purchase it on your behalf providing you pay for it (at cost) upon booking. Whatever you decide we can keep any champagne chilled until you require it and provide you with champagne flutes.

Start times - For options 1 & 2, you can book either morning or afternoon dependant on the date and our availability, dependant on time of year. For option 3, these always start at 10am.

Party Extra's

We can put bow ties on the llamas and alpacas as a bit of fun, there is no charge for this, but please do ask on booking, not every Hen Party wants this so we don't do it automatically. **Sashes** for humans! Can be hired for the trek at £2 each.

We offer a lovely llama **'Bride to be 'Gift Bag'** at £25, which includes some keep safes for the bride and their very own llama, plus a **'Hen Party Guest Book'**, which is perfect for everyone to write messages in & sign!

You can purchase a Hen Party Guest Book separately for £8 includes pen, please let us know should you like one on booking.

Or why not **'adopt the llama or alpaca'** the bride to be treks with, as a little extra surprise gift! All adoptions arranged for Brides receive 10% off when purchased on booking.

Useful Information

Booking - Once you have agreed a date and time with us, we require a 50% non-refundable deposit to secure your booking. By paying your deposit you are agreeing to our [Terms & Conditions](#) so please refer to these prior to booking. Please contact us should you have any questions or queries over the them. If you are unsure of final numbers, we suggest you book for the minimum number of llamas, then at least you have secured the date and time. We will then require final numbers & any remaining deposit, 4 weeks prior to trek, final numbers then determine the final balance payable 7 days prior to the booking date. No refunds are given if the numbers on the day are less than your final numbers. Confirmation of your booking will be e-mailed to you both on receipt of your deposit and a final e-mail on receipt of the balance.

Directions – Once you have booked your Hen Party we will send you a pdf with directions. It is important that the directions are circulated around all drivers so that everybody finds us ok ready for your start time. Sometimes SAT NAV's can take you to the wrong part of the farm.

We have to stick to start times due to our daily schedule.

Late arrivals may miss out on the introduction and the trek!

Clothing – Everyone should dress sensibly and casually as if for a country walk.

Trousers are recommended even in the Summer months as some of the tracks can be over grown. Good strong footwear is essential. We can't allow anyone to trek in open toed shoes or sandals, flip flops, plimsolls or fashion boots. Walking boots, wellingtons or strong trainers are fine, be prepared for some mud!

We do keep some spare wellingtons at hire these out at £2 pr pair. We sell socks at £1 pr pair or bring your own!

Pregnant Ladies – There are no restriction of pregnant ladies llama trekking, providing they are efficient with their hand washing and are physically able to walk the distance of the trek chosen. It is entirely at the discretion of the pregnant lady to whether she feels able to trek and happy to engage on the experience. We do however recommend all pregnant ladies share a llama as opposed to have their own as some elements of the trekking environment are over slightly hazardous terrain.

Please notify us if you have pregnant ladies in your group so we can ensure they are given the appropriate llamas. (we have llamas that are perfect for pregnant ladies)!!

Babies and Children - We regret no babies or children are allowed to accompany treks and no babies or children under the age of 7 yrs are permitted on the farm. We can not therefore allow ladies to allow their partners to meet with them on the farm with babies etc. There are also age restrictions on our trek options, therefore if you have children within your group please contact us to discuss if it is feasible for them to join you.
